He focuses especially on slavery as central to the economy, culture, and political thought of the colonists needed the expertise, guidance, alliance, and trade of the Indians who dominated the interior. This historical approach emphasizes the ability of the diverse natives to adapt to the new comers and to compel concessions from them.
